SAGE Access for Municipal Consultants: Engineers, Engineering Consulting Firms and Other Consultants

Municipalities

- DCA SAGE maintains registration information on all NJ municipalities for both DCA and DOT SAGE.*
- Municipal Contacts (employees who have been given access to SAGE) can login to both DCA SAGE and DOT SAGE* with the same user name and logon ID.
- A municipal employee is an individual (not a firm) who works directly for the municipality and receives a paycheck and Federal W-2 Tax Form from the municipality.
- Municipal applications for grant funding must be *initiated* and *submitted* solely by municipal
 personnel. Following grant application initiation, an engineering or other consultant can then
 be assigned to assist with application preparation provided that the consultant has secured
 SAGE (DCA or DOT, as appropriate) access under the auspices of the consultant's own
 corporate affiliation.
- Consultants are not municipal employees, and should be given access to individual municipal
 applications or grants only as Consultants (for DCA applications and grants, see the <u>DCA</u>
 SAGE User Manual for DOT applications and grants, see the <u>NJDOT User Manual</u>).

Engineering and Other Consulting Firms

- DCA and DOT SAGE* *do not* share registration information on private organizations, such as engineering and other consulting firms.
- Engineering and other consulting firms must register separately in DCA SAGE or DOT SAGE, or both. *
- Employees of private organizations need a separate user name and logon ID for DCA and/or DOT SAGE * under the auspices of their actual corporate affiliation.
- Consultants are not municipal employees, and should be given access to individual municipal
 applications or grants as Consultants (for DCA applications and grants, see the <u>DCA SAGE</u>
 User Manual for DOT applications and grants, see the <u>NJDOT User Manual</u>).
